The applicant hereby represents the following:

- (a) That in the preceding 5 year period, a bona fide membership engaged in carrying out organizational objectives.
- (b) That the entire net proceeds of the aforementioned raffle will be exclusively devoted to the lawful purpose of the organization.
- (c) That the retail value of all prizes or merchandise will not exceed \$50,000 and the maximum retail value of each prize will not exceed \$25,000.
- (d) That the maximum price for each chance will not exceed \$500.
- (e) That chances will be sold within a period not to exceed 60 days.
- (f) That only bona fide members of the organization shall participate in the management or operation of the raffle.

- (g) That no person shall receive enumeration of profit for participating in the management or operation of the raffle.
- (h) That no person under the age of 18 years will participate in conducting the raffle.
- (i) That no person under the age of 18 years will be present when winners are determined unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- (j) That if premises are rented for the purpose of determining winners, the lessor is also licensed under this act.
- (k) That no person connected with the proposed raffle is ineligible for a license under the criteria set forth in Sec. 2302 of the ILL. Rev. Stats., Chapter 85.
- (l) That records of gross receipts, expenses and net proceeds will be segregated from other revenue and that the person who keeps such records shall not be the same person who accounts for other revenue of the organization.
- (m) That gross receipts, expenses and net proceeds will be reported to the membership of the organization and to the Champaign County Clerk after conclusion of the raffle.
- (n) That required records will be preserved for 3 years after raffle and available for public inspection at reasonable times and places.
- (o) That the applicant organization is a not-for-profit corporation or association and has been in existence continuously for a period of at least 5 years immediately before date hereof.
